**Text:**

Assia Djébar is the pen-name of Fatima Zohra Imalayen. She is an Algerian novelist, poet, playwright, translator and film maker. She was born on August 4<sup>th</sup>, 1936 in Cherchel, a small coastal town near Algiers.



Assia attended the primary school where her father taught French. In 1955, she was the first Algerian woman to be accepted at the “École Normale Supérieure” an elite college in Paris where she studied History. Two years later, she published her first novel, ‘La soif’. In 1962, she published ‘Les enfants du nouveau monde’ and in 1967, ‘Les alouettes naïves’. She also wrote and directed her own films. She won the Biennale prize at the 1979 Venice Film Festival with her very first attempt, “La Nouba des Femmes du Mont Chenoua”.

Assia won the prestigious ‘Neustadt’ prize for contribution to world literature in 1996, and the next year, the ‘Yourcenar’ prize.

Djébar is considered one of North Africa’s most famous and influential writers, and was elected to the ‘Académie Française’ on June 16, 2005.. Djébar worked as a professor of francophone literature at New York University.

Assia Djébar died on February 6<sup>th</sup> 2015 at the age of 78 in Paris, France.
