

Text:

Harun al-Rashid was born on 17 March 763 in Rey, near Tehran, Iran. He was the son of al-Mahdi, the third Abbasid caliph (ruled 775 – 786), and al-Khayzuran, a former slave girl from Yemen, who was a woman of strong personality. Most of his time was dedicated to mastering Hadith and Quran.

In addition, he underwent advanced physical education as a future mujahid, and as a result, he practiced swordplay, archery, and learned the art of war. At the age of 18, a few years before becoming caliph, Harun married his cousin Amat al-Aziz (nicknamed Zubaidah).

Harun al-Rashid became caliph in 786 when he was in his early twenties. At the time, he was tall, good looking, and slim but strongly built, with wavy hair and olive skin. Under Harun al-Rashid's rule, Baghdad flourished into the most splendid city of its period. Harun made pilgrimages to Mecca by camel (1,750 miles from Baghdad) several times. Because of the Thousand and One Nights tales, Harun al-Rashid turned into a legendary figure obscuring his true historic personality. In fact, his reign initiated the political disintegration of the Abbasid caliphate. He died in Tus, Iran on 24th March 809.
