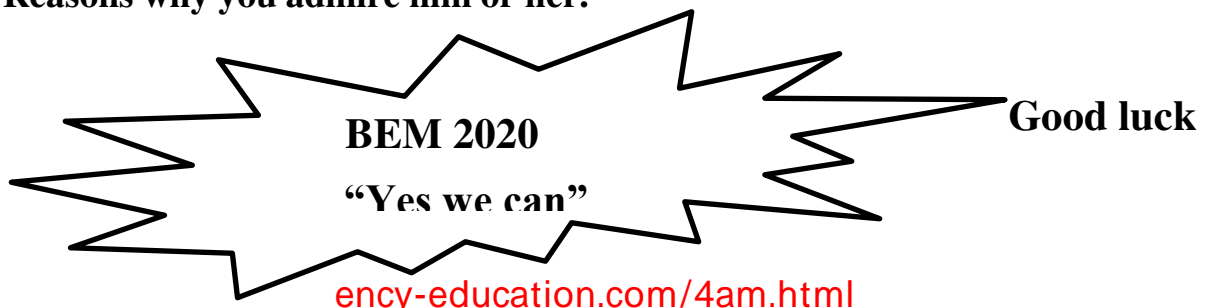
Section two: The situation of integration (6pts)
