Finland is recognised worldwide for its top ranking education model. Foreign delegations frequently visit the country to try and discover the secret of <u>its</u> success. Euronews spent a day at a school in the capital Helsinki to find out more about the philosophy behind the Finnish system.

Finland has the shortest formal teaching hours in Europe and the best educational results. Finnish children stay with the same class and the same teacher for at least six years –which makes school like an extension of home.

In Finland, competition to become a teacher is so fierce that all teachers have a Master's degree. Heljä Misukka, the Secretary of State for Education, told Euronews: "What is also maybe quite special in Finland is that teachers are quite autonomous in what they do, so <u>they</u> can, for example, choose the materials they like or the pedagogy they use. They have a lot of freedom in their work." The focus is on music, sport and the arts. Children learn by playing and experimenting in groups, like the science class. Playtime is an important part of learning. There are a lot of breaks and even in winter children are encouraged to play outdoors. The children are trusted.

However, Charles Lead beater, a global education analyst told us: "We shouldn't think that <u>it</u> is the only model that we should follow; it's one very effective model in teaching, learning and schooling, but it's not necessarily the only, or in some cases the best, model to improve education."
