*Read the text carefully then do the following activities.*

The Persian Empire, also known as the Achaemenid Empire, lasted from approximately 559 B.C.E. to 331 B.C.E. At its height, it encompassed the areas of modern-day Iran, Egypt, Turkey, and parts of Afghanistan and Pakistan. The Persian Empire became the world's first superpower. **It** united under one government three important sites of early human civilizations in the ancient world: Mesopotamia, Egypt's Nile Valley and India's Indus Valley.

The Persian Empire emerged under the leadership of Cyrus the Great who was called the "shah". Cyrus was known for his mercy and cultural tolerance toward conquered people. He allowed the Jews, who had been captives in Babylon for over fifty years to return to the holy city of El-Quds in Palestine, instead of turning **them** into slaves. He returned sacred items that were stolen from them and allowed the rebuilding of their temple.

Cyrus's relative Darius I took the throne after **him** and built the empire to its greatest height. Darius recognized that such a large area needed to be properly structured and organized in order to function efficiently. He set up a system of provinces and governors, and the first postal service that spanned the empire in order to establish widespread communication between three continents—Africa, Asia and Europe.

The Persian Empire began to decline under the reign of Darius's son who depleted the royal treasury with an unsuccessful campaign to invade Greece and continued with irresponsible spending upon returning home. Persia was eventually conquered by the Roman -Alexander the Great- in 334 B.C.E.
