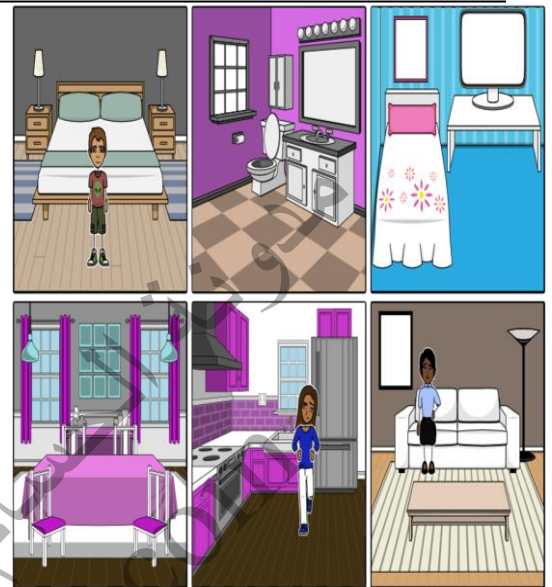


The First Term English Exam

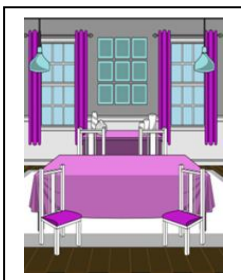
My house is like a paradise for me, the place where I find happiness and spend my leisure time.

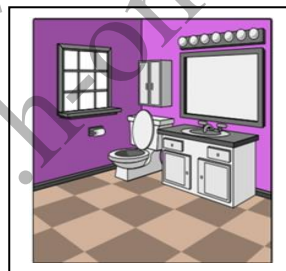

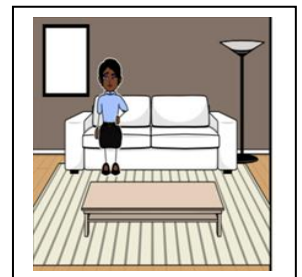

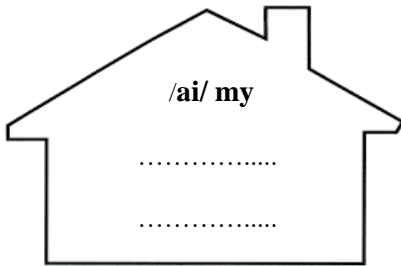
